WHEREAS, on the 8th day of February, 2016, the Commissioners' Court of Panola County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;





ORDER #2016-02




WHEREAS, on the 8th day of February, 2016, the Commissioners' Court of Panola County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;


- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, April 21, 2016, whichever is earlier.




