I'm glad you asked this question because GeoComm emailed me about adding Cherokee and Panola to our mapping cleanup project. If both counties are on board I need to let GeoComm know so ETCOG can obtain a quote on the cost. Also, as an FYI, if Cherokee and Panola County want to participate there is **no cost to them at all** for this. The ETCOG 911 program will cover all expenses for mapping clean up. We are allowed to

cover the expenses because Cherokee and Panola counties are a part of our 911 program. The only counties we cannot cover are Henderson, Harrison, Rusk and Smith because they have their own 911 districts. And It is really in the best interest, of both counties, to become a part of this process now while ETCOG can pay for it. Thanks.
