NOTES TO THE SALARY SCHEDULE

Any positions which reflect hourly rates and salaries in excess of General Fund budgeted amounts are funded partially or entirely from special revenues available by state or federal law for particular offices. This includes employees in the District Attorney, Sheriff, Tax Assessor/Collector, and the Bailiff & Security Officer.

The District Attorney's Office has State Funds, Forfeiture Funds & Hot Check Fee Funds which can be used for the official statutory purposes of the office. Drug Court Grant Funds supplement the District Attorney Investigator salary.

The Sheriff's office has forfeiture funds which can be used for the official statutory purposes of the office.

The District Attorney's & Sheriff's Office State Forfeiture Funds can be budgeted by the District Attorney & Sheriff with only certain salary increases requiring approval by the Commissioners Court in accordance with applicable statutes.

The Sheriff can submit budgets for salaries from the Federal Forfeiture fund and those budgets are approved by the Sheriff and Commissioners Court.

Any salary increases paid out of the State or Federal Forfeiture Funds are considered to be approved by the Commissioners Court by approval of this salary schedule.

At the discretion of the Tax Assessor/Collector the interest off of Vehicle Inventory Taxes may be used to supplement employee's salaries who administer the pre-payment of vehicle inventory taxes.

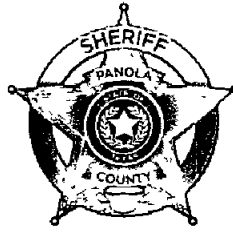
Courthouse Security funds are used to partially fund the Bailiff and Security Officer.

Any persons during the year filling vacated positions denoted with uniform, clothing allowances, or holiday pay shall automatically receive the same allowances unless otherwise changed by the Commissioners Court or the department head.

Some of the hourly rates and salaries reflect amounts which are below the budgeted amounts. As a part of this salary schedule approval, it is understood that most elected official or department heads can raise the salary levels to the total maximum budgeted amount for that line item. This can be done by submitting a request to Commissioners Court to record the increase in the minutes of the Court. Any increases for Road & Bridge employees require Commissioners' Court approval. No Salaries from the General Fund, Federal Forfeiture Fund, Courthouse Security Fund, Road & Bridge Fund and/or FM & Lateral Fund can exceed the original budgeted salary or wages line unless the Commissioners Court grants such increase by budget amendment. As described earlier, some special revenue funds are available for additional salaries and wages in accordance with State and Federal statutes.

It is further understood that in the future should for any reason the county need to work, improve, relocate, widen, increase, add to, or in any manner change the structure of this right-of-way, any required relocation of said lines shall be at the sole expense of owner

All work on the county right-of-way shall be performed in accordance with the county instructions. The installations shall not damage any part of the road and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent owners. Special specifications for placing this line are as follows

- 1 All lines are to be installed a minimum of 36 inches below the flow line of the adjacent drainage or barrow ditch
- 2 All excavation within the right-of-way and not under surfacing shall be backfilled by tamping in 6 inch horizontal layers. All surplus material shall be removed from the right-of-way and the excavation finished flush with surrounding natural ground
- 3 Lines crossing under surfaced roads and under surfacing cross roads within the right-of-way shall be placed by boring. Boring shall extend from crown line to crown line. Gravity from sewer lines under roadways shall be cast iron pipe
- 4 All lines, where practicable, shall be located to cross roadbed at approximately right angles thereto. No lines are to be installed under or within 50 feet of either end of any bridge. No lines shall be placed in any culvert or within 10 feet of the closest point of same.
- 5 Parallel line will be installed as near the right-of-way lines as is possible and

no parallel line will be installed in the roadbed or between the drainage ditch and the roadbed without special permission of the Panola County Commissioners' Court.
