

**AMENDED CONTRACT FOR
PANOLA COUNTY MORGUE SERVICES**

This contract shall be entered into between **Jimerson-Lipsey Funeral Home**, a Texas Corporation, and the **County of Panola**, Texas, a governmental body. The term of this contract shall be for a period of ten (10) years from July 18, 2016 to July 18, 2026.


The County of Panola hereby authorizes the relocation of the County Morgue equipment from its present location at Hawthorn Funeral Home to premises owned by Jimerson-Lipsey Funeral Home

Jimerson-Lipsey Funeral Home agrees to provide the installation of the County Morgue equipment mentioned above on their premises at its expense; and shall also provide operating room facilities and staff members to assist in removal of dead human bodies from place of death to the Panola County Morgue. Charges will be made in accordance with regular Funeral Home pricing for the removal of the body from place of death and transfer of the dead human bodies from the Panola County Morgue to a distant location for an autopsy to be performed. (General Price List Attached)

The County of Panola shall deem Jimerson-Lipsey Funeral Home facilities to be the Panola County Morgue, therefore, with complete operating room facilities available and permanent full-time staff members of the facility available 24 hours per day.


This contract is agreed upon and signed this 18th day of July, 2016, by Stuart Lipsey, manager of Jimerson-Lipsey Funeral Home, and Lee Ann Jones, County Judge, Commissioners' Court, County of Panola, State of Texas.

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

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

 Service charge for ground burial preparation and completion by funeral home arranged contractor in cemeteries local to Panola County area. NOTE: Cemeteries in or out of Panola County area may require their internal staff perform this service. In such cases, only fees assessed by the cemetery will be assessed to the client. Also, additional charges may be incurred for service in cemeteries outside of the Panola County area.

OPENING & CLOSING OF GRAVE FOR URN BURIAL (within service area). \$525
 Service charge for ground burial preparation and completion by funeral home arranged contractor in cemeteries local to Panola County area. NOTE: Cemeteries in or out of Panola County area may require their internal staff perform this service. In such cases, only fees assessed by the cemetery will be assessed to the client. Also, additional charges may be incurred for service in cemeteries outside of the Panola County area. Hole = \$175 Tent = \$350

FULL TRADITIONAL FUNERAL SERVICE

(excluding opening & closing of grave and merchandise) \$4,320.00

(excluding opening & closing of grave and merchandise) \$4,270.00
 You may elect not to use any item included to the preceding prices with the exception of BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL (with casket provided by the purchaser) \$3,490.00
 (with minimum steel casket, excluding opening & closing of grave and merchandise). . . \$4,485.00

Our charge for immediate burial (*without services*) include: basic service of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains (*within a 35 mile radius*), necessary transportation to cemetery, completion of necessary authorizations; filing death certificate, and use of facility for the shelter of body. This charge DOES NOT include the use of the facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, at the funeral.

DIRECT CREMATION SERVICES \$2,745.00 to \$6,116.00

Our charge for direct cremation (*without services*) include: basic service of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains (*within a 25 mile radius*), necessary transportation to crematory; completion of necessary authorizations, filing death certificate, and use of facility for the shelter of body. This charge DOES NOT include the use of the facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, at the funeral home, graveside and elsewhere. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of material like fiberboard and composition materials (with or without an outside covering)

FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$3,100.00

Reduced basic services include: Removal of remains, basic services of staff, necessary authorizations, embalming, local transportation (excluding shipping charges and container). Not included are casket purchase, use of facilities and staff for visitation / ceremonies

RECEIVE REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$2,700.00

Services include: Basic services of staff, transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory. Not included are visitation / ceremonies

Our price list does not include cash advance items that you might ask us to purchase for you such as family flowers, certified copies of the death certificate, inscription of the final date on a monument or marker, honorarium for clergy and musicians, paid newspaper obituaries, cemetery or crematory charges, private and common carrier (airline) transportation, shipping and receiving, funeral director's charges and these charges will be added at current market price, and we will pay for these items on the date we are paid. If we make a charge for buying any specific item, it will be specified in our Statement of Funeral Goods and Services
