

**PETITION TO PERMANENTLY ABANDON, CLOSE AND DISCONTINUE
PANOLA COUNTY ROAD NO. 4082**

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT, PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS:

Richard Michael Murphy and Denise Weaver Murphy, landowners in Precinct No. 4, Panola County, Texas, pursuant to Section 251.052 of the Texas Transportation Code, hereby petitions the Commissioners Court of Panola County, Texas, to permanently abandon and discontinue the existing Panola County Road No. 4082, hereinafter more particularly identified as the County Road to be permanently abandoned, and in support thereof, presents to the Court the following facts:

I.

The Panola County Road No. 4082 to be permanently discontinued and abandoned is as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and more particularly described as the beginning of County Road No. 4082 traveling down said County Road No. 4082 and ending at Petitioners' eastern boundary line, said section of road lies in the A. G. Hudson Survey, A-345, and the Julia Soape Survey, A-870.

The description of Panola County Road No. 4082 to be permanently discontinued and abandoned is as shown on the attached Exhibit "A". The attached Exhibit "A" shows the beginning and termination point of Panola County Road No. 4082 to be permanently discontinued and abandoned.

II.

The permanent discontinuing and abandonment of Panola County Road No. 4082, as shown on the Exhibit "A", will permit private use of the property by said landowner.

III.

Richard Michael Murphy and Denise Weaver Murphy own the land on both sides of Panola County Road No. 4082 to be permanently abandoned, as shown and referred to herein on attached Exhibit "A".

IV.

In accordance with Section 251.052 of the Texas Transportation Code, Petitioners have given notice of their intent to apply to the Commissioners Court for an Order to permanently abandon and discontinue Panola County Road No. 4082, as herein described and referred to, and that such notice was made by written advertisement of their intent, posted at the courthouse door of Panola County, Texas, and at two (2) other places in the vicinity of the County Road affected, for more than twenty (20) days, a copy of such Notice and written advertisement being attached hereto.

Accordingly, Petitioners respectfully request the Commissioners Court of Panola County, Texas, to enter an order permanently discontinuing and abandoning Panola County Road No. 4082 as described and referred to herein.

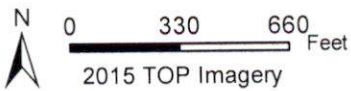
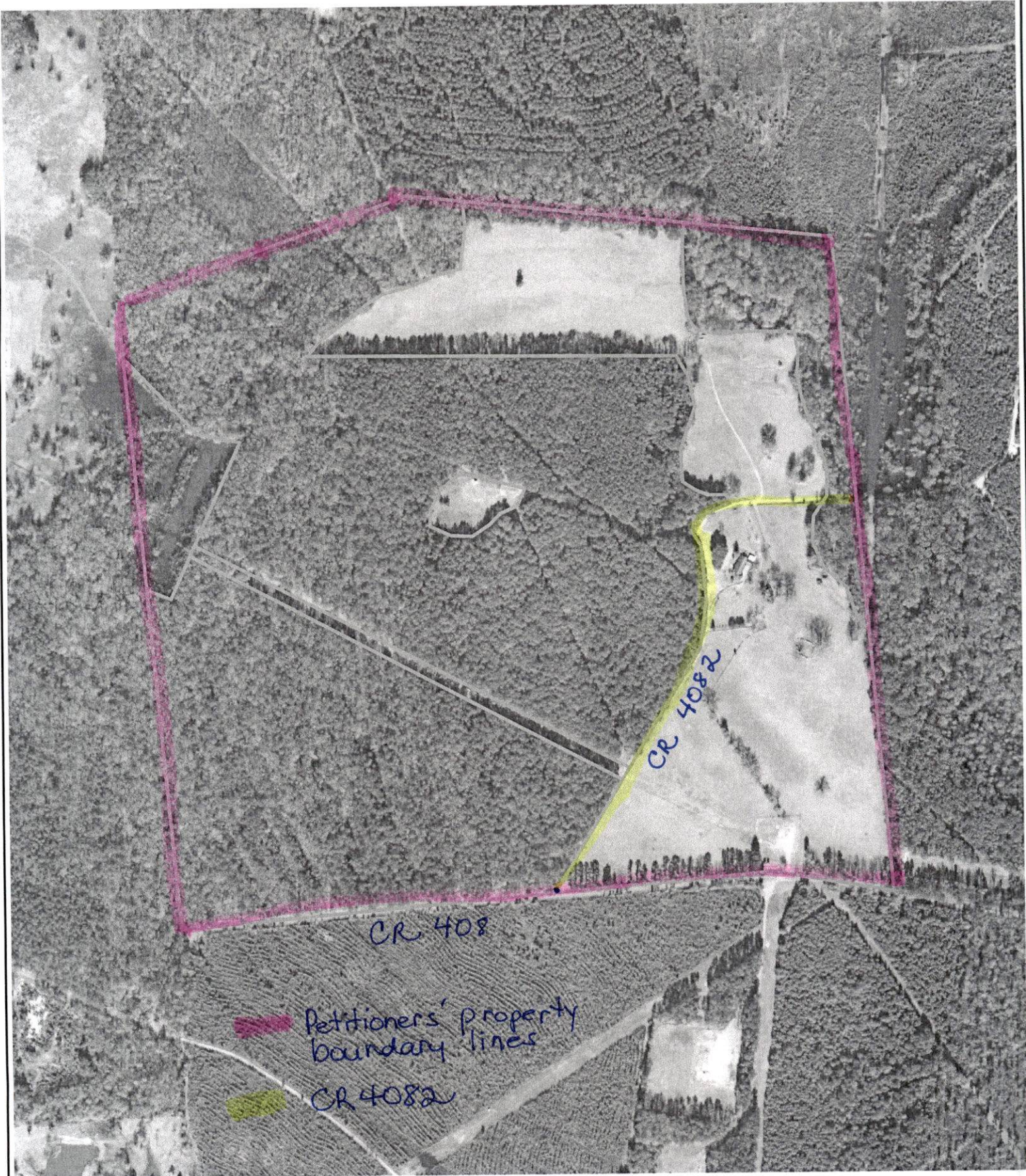


Exhibit "A"
