Dear Texas A&M Agrilife Extension Service,

Panola County in an effort to reduce the feral hog population and the damage caused by these animals, is applying for the County Feral Hog Grant.

If awarded this grant Panola County will increase efforts to eradicate feral hogs in Panola County. Below is a list of programs already in place that the County Extension Agent sponsors each year.

- 1. September 27, 2018 Feral Hog Management & Board Buster Trapping System Presented by: Joshua A. Gaskamp, Noble Research Institute & Jared Laing, TPWD
- 2. November 16, 2018 East Texas Beef & Forage Clinic Feral Hogs in East Texas; Jamie Sugg, Rusk County Extension Agent, presenter.

Future program efforts for 2019 will include a multi county wildlife program in September 2019 and a breakfast program to be held on November 7, 2019 covering Feral Hog issues. Panola County has a "Panola Wildlife and Forestry Planning Committee" that meets quarterly to discuss county issues such as feral hog management.
