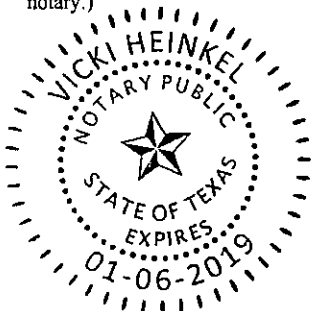

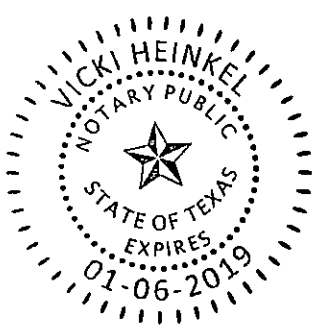


The undersigned is aware that Judge Rafferty recently approached the Commissioners Court of both Panola and Shelby County requesting that she be paid supplements to her State Salary. It is my understanding that the Panola County Commissioners approved a \$9,000 supplement and that the Shelby County Commissioners approved a \$3,000 supplement to her salary.

The creation of the Panola County Court at Law is found in Section 25.1852 of the Texas Government Code. This section provides that the Judge of the County Court at Law has concurrent jurisdiction with the District Court. That basically means that I hear the same cases that the District Judge hears and also hear all misdemeanor, juvenile, probate, and eminent domain cases. Subsection (d) of the creating statute provides in part that the annual salary of the Judge of the County Court at Law shall be at least "equal to the amount that is \$1,000.00 less than the total annual salary, including supplements, received by a district judge in the county".

I have served as Judge of the County Court at Law for 20 years, and during this time I have never asked for a supplement to my salary. Due to the caseload that my office has maintained, the county has always paid me the same salary as the district judge. It is now requested that the County Court at Law Judge be paid the same supplement in accordance with the statute.

I have enclosed a copy of the Statute for your review.
