The Panola County Commissioners' Court offers no objection to the location on the right-of-way of your proposed **10" temporary water line** within the right-of-way of County Road **#444** as shown by accompanying drawings and notice except as noted below.

It is expressly understood that the County Commissioners' Court does not purpose hereby, to grant any right, claim, title or easement in or upon this county road. It is further understood that in the future should for any reason the county need to work, improve, relocate, widen, increase, add to, or in any manner change the structure of this right-of-way, any required relocation of said lines shall be at the sole expense of owner.

All work on the county right-of-way shall be performed in accordance with the county instructions. The installations shall not damage any part of the road and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent owners. Special specifications for placing this line are as follows:

- 1. All lines are to be installed a minimum of 36 inches below the flow line of the adjacent drainage or barrow ditch.
- All excavation within the right-of-way and not under surfacing shall be backfilled by tamping in 6 inch horizontal layers. All surplus material shall be removed from the right-of-way and the excavation finished flush with surrounding natural ground.
- Lines crossing under surfaced roads and under surfacing cross roads within the right-of-way shall be placed by boring. Boring shall extend from crown line to crown line. Gravity from sewer lines under roadways shall be cast iron pipe.



Also, someone asked about the VA Fiduciary Program, so I invite a Field Examiner from the Lincoln Fiduciary Hub to speak to us. All have agreed to participate. This is great information in and informal setting. Take the time to network, relax and learn what you may not know.

I'm trying to provide you with information we do not training on all the time. You know on to do claims, but you also need to know about the VHA programs. Not all veterans are eligible for VA Compensation or VA Pension, but all are concern a VA Health care. I sure most veteran do not know about the VA or how to contact them, but I sure they know on to contact the (VA man or VA lady) in their county. For them that's you. We have to be able to tell them (no you cannot take an ambulance to pick up your medicine/no you cannot take a taxi from VAMC Houston to Bowie county because the doctor said go straight home), yes both has been done and they expected the VA to pay for it. I have invited someone from the TVC Health Care Advocacy Program to tell you how they can help with situations based the VHA Topics. Some of you have to new VetraSpec program or would like to know more about it, so I invite the TVC Point of Contact to join us.

Lastly, I will tell you about some nice to know VHA Medical programs: Adult Day Health Care, Home Based Primary Care, Homemaker and Home

Health Aide Care, Hospice Care, Palliative Care, Respite Care, and Remote Monitoring Care. Again, we cannot tell veterans these programs are available if we do not know about them.

As I stated before if I get the Power Point ahead of time I will send it out to. I asked the speakers if you could submit question now for them to be prepared to answer they said yes. So, send mw you question on the topics listed above and I will pass then to the speakers. PLEASE do not ask them to tell you about a particular veteran or your personal case.
