1. CITIZEN COMMENTS:

Jeremy Romero shared with the Court his concerns about the safety of CR 233. Commissioner David Cole stated that he would take Mr. Romero's concerns under consideration.

2. COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS:

Commissioner Ronnie LaGrone reported that, as authorized, he has initiated negotiations with the City of Carthage to possibly trade for property in front of the Exposition Building. If approved and finalized, the County will build an office building to house the Extension Offices, Voter Offices, storage rooms and meeting rooms.

Commissioner Ronnie LaGrone moved and Commissioner David A. Cole seconded the motion to approve the Consent Items. The motion passed unanimously.


