SECOND AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF AN ANIMAL POUND

Whereas, the City of Carthage, Texas ("City") and Panola County, Texas ("County") (collectively, the "Parties") are political subdivisions of the State of Texas and are entering this Agreement in compliance with Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code; and

Whereas, the City has a contract with a third-party independent contractor to provide for impoundment of stray animals; and

Whereas, the County desires to utilize the City Animal Pound and to pay a fair share of the cost of such Animal Pound; and

Whereas, the Commissioners' Court of Panola County, Texas and the City Commission of the City of Carthage, Texas do hereby deem it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Panola County and the City of Carthage to make this Second Amendment to the February 14, 2011 Agreement as follows:

Section II. Rights and Obligations of the Parties, Part B. In consideration of the City's oversight of the management and operations of the Animal Pound, the County shall pay to the City one-half the amount for a total of FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS and one-half the monthly dumpster pickup fees for a total of FIFTY-THREE AND NO/100 (\$53.00) DOLLARS. Therefore, the total monthly payment from the County to the City will be FIVE THOUSAND FIFTY-THREE AND NO/100 (\$5,053.00) DOLLARS monthly payable on the 15th day of each month beginning January 1, 2020. The County will also reimburse the City for ½ of the cost to purchase a 21-cu. ft. refrigerator and a 22-cu. ft. chest type freezer in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.

Section II. Rights and Obligations of the Parties, Part C. Fees for animals that are required to be quarantined or kept over the stated time will be paid by the City or County, respectively.

No other changes or amendments are made.
