The Panola County Commissioners' Court offers no objection to the location on the right-of-way of your proposed **2" ID water transfer & 6" ID gas pipe line** within the right-of-way of County Road **#161** as shown by accompanying drawings and notice except as noted below.

It is expressly understood that the County Commissioners' Court does not purpose hereby, to grant any right, claim, title or easement in or upon this county road. It is further understood that in the future should for any reason the county need to work, improve, relocate, widen, increase, add to, or in any manner change the structure of this right-of-way, any required relocation of said lines shall be at the sole expense of owner.

All work on the county right-of-way shall be performed in accordance with the county instructions. The installations shall not damage any part of the road and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent owners. Special specifications for placing this line are as follows:

- 1. All lines are to be installed a minimum of 36 inches below the flow line of the adjacent drainage or barrow ditch.
- 2. All excavation within the right-of-way and not under surfacing shall be backfilled by tamping in 6 inch horizontal layers. All surplus material shall be removed from the right-of-way and the excavation finished flush with surrounding natural ground.
- 3. Lines crossing under surfaced roads and under surfacing cross roads within the right-of-way shall be placed by boring. Boring shall extend from crown line to crown line. Gravity from sewer lines under roadways shall be cast iron pipe.
- 4. All lines, where practicable, shall be located to cross roadbed at approximately right angles thereto. No lines are to be installed under or within 50 feet of either end of any bridge. No lines shall be placed in any culvert or within 10 feet of the closest point of same.

- 5. Parallel line will be installed as near the right-of-way lines as is possible and no parallel line will be installed in the roadbed or between the drainage ditch and the roadbed without special permission of the Panola County Commissioners' Court.
- 6. Operations along roadbeds shall be performed in such manner that all excavated material be kept off the pavement at all times, as well as all operating equipment and materials. No equipment or installation procedures will be used which will damage any road surface or structures. The cost of any repairs to road surface, roadbed, structures or other right-of-way features as a direct result of this installation will be borne by the owner of this line.





## TERMS YOU MAY NOT BE FAMILIAR WITH

C.O.P.S. defines survivors as spouses, children, parents, siblings, fiancés, significant others, extended family members, co-workers, and friends. Co-Workers are included in the current year survivors', returning survivors' and historical survivors' definitions.

CURRENT YEAR SURVIVORS: All survivors of the officers honored during the May 4th Memorial Ceremony.

RETURNING SURVIVORS: All survivors of an officer who were honored in previous years.

HISTORICAL SURVIVORS: All survivors of the officers honored at the Candlelight Vigil **only**. Historical survivors are not honored during the May 4th Memorial Ceremony.

THE PRIMARY SURVIVOR: will be placed in order of recognition. These survivors include the spouse, children, parents, and then siblings of the fallen officers honored. If the officer was not married or the spouse is not present, the responsibility of receiving the resolutions and medal from the State of Texas will pass to the next in line to serve as the "primary survivor."

NON-PARTICIPATING FAMILY MEMBER: will include extended family members: aunts, uncles, grandparents, nieces, nephews, cousins, in-laws, friends and co-workers of the fallen officer being honored. On May 4th, these survivors will need to follow directions provided for "Extended Family."

STAND-IN OFFICER: Each agency, along with the family of the fallen officer, should choose one department officer to represent the family and the officer's department at the Ceremony on May 4. 




## **EVENT INFORMATION**

During the Candlelight Vigil, restroom facilities are available in the Sam Houston Building directly behind the Monument. All facilities are disability accessible.




