Please accept this letter as notice of my retirement from the office of Sheriff effective May 14, 2021. I have served in the field of law enforcement in Panola County going some 29 years. It has been a rewarding career, with both happy times, as well as sad times. I have served with all of my heart in order to fulfill my duties, with the best interest of our citizens, and the county in mind. I have made good decision, and I have made not so good ones, but when I failed, I always tried to first own the mistake, then make it right for the sake of everyone involved. I have made many friends along the way, and I have gained so many memories that I'll cherish for the remainder of my life.

It has been the good working relationship with my County Commissioners and County Judges through the years that has made both my career, as well as the entire Sheriff's Office successful in our duties. I thank each of you for your part in our working relationship.

With my retirement, comes the decision of the court in the appointment of a Sheriff to fill the vacancy until a mid-term special election is held. If it pleases the court, I would respectfully like to make a recommendation for that appointment for the court's consideration. When thinking about a successor for the office of Sheriff, there is much to consider. In considering a person for this position, I must stand on my belief that it should be an individual from within the current staff of the department. I believe this to be true because the successor must be someone who is familiar with the staff, familiar with the day-to-day operations, as well as the many moving parts of the department. As a result, I have taken a long hard look at the senior staff of the department. Chief Jeff Ivy would have been my obvious choice, but due to other future plans, he feels this is not the right move for him at this time. My next obvious choice is Captain Sarah Fields. Sarah is currently the longest serving member of the Panola County Sheriff's Office. She has served in some capacity, in every division of the Sheriff's Office during her 30+ years of service. Sarah started as a secretary/dispatcher, moving her way up through the ranks of civil process, criminal investigations, to currently the third in command of the entire department, in her position of

Captain. Sarah has represented Panola County professionally on a state level for many years on the State Child Fatality Review Team, as well as the head of the East Texas Child Fatality Review team for many years. As a result of her investigative work, she has touched the countless lives of families during this time. Sarah holds the highest level of law enforcement certification as a Texas Master Peace Officer. This does not come easy, I know! I firmly believe that Captain Sarah Fields has all of the qualities necessary to successfully lead the Panola County Sheriff's Office, along with Chief Ivy and whoever the deserving individual may be to replace Sarah's current position as Captain of the department, if she is appointed by the court.

I humbly and respectfully ask the court to accept my professional recommendation of Captain Sarah Fields to be appointed by the court to fill the vacancy of the office of Sheriff upon my retirement. I send this letter at this time, because there will need to be an adequate transition period for me to work with the person who will fill my vacancy prior to my departure. I would request the time frame of approximately three (3) months of training and transition prior to my retirement to ensure a smooth transition.

The Panola County Commissioners' Court offers no objection to the location on the right-of-way of your proposed **2" Casing with a 3/4" service line** within the right-of-way of County Road **#201** as shown by accompanying drawings and notice except as noted below.

It is expressly understood that the County Commissioners' Court does not purpose hereby, to grant any right, claim, title or easement in or upon this county road. It is further understood that in the future should for any reason the county need to work, improve, relocate, widen, increase, add to, or in any manner change the structure of this right-of-way, any required relocation of said lines shall be at the sole expense of owner.

All work on the county right-of-way shall be performed in accordance with the county instructions. The installations shall not damage any part of the road and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent owners. Special specifications for placing this line are as follows:

- 1. All lines are to be installed a minimum of 36 inches below the flow line of the adjacent drainage or barrow ditch.
- 2. All excavation within the right-of-way and not under surfacing shall be backfilled by tamping in 6 inch horizontal layers. All surplus material shall be removed from the right-of-way and the excavation finished flush with surrounding natural ground.
- Lines crossing under surfaced roads and under surfacing cross roads within the right-of-way shall be placed by boring. Boring shall extend from crown line to crown line. Gravity from sewer lines under roadways shall be cast iron pipe.
- 4. All lines, where practicable, shall be located to cross roadbed at approximately right angles thereto. No lines are to be installed under or within 50 feet of either end of any bridge. No lines shall be placed in any culvert or within 10 feet of the closest point of same.

- 5. Parallel line will be installed as near the right-of-way lines as is possible and no parallel line will be installed in the roadbed or between the drainage ditch and the roadbed without special permission of the Panola County Commissioners' Court.
- 6. Operations along roadbeds shall be performed in such manner that all excavated material be kept off the pavement at all times, as well as all operating equipment and materials. No equipment or installation procedures will be used which will damage any road surface or structures. The cost of any repairs to road surface, roadbed, structures or other right-of-way features as a direct result of this installation will be borne by the owner of this line.
- 7. Barricades, warning signs, lights, and flag man(men) when necessary shall be provided by the contractor or owner. One-half (1/2) of the traveled portion of the road must be open at all times.






