

OPEN MEETING:

1. CITIZEN COMMENTS:

- 7. Commissioner Billy Alexander moved and Commissioner Craig M. Lawless seconded the motion to approve a Proposed Election Agreement between Gary ISD and Panola County. The motion carried unanimously, with County Judge LeeAnn Jones absent. SEE PROPOSED AGREEMENT ATTACHED.
- 8. Commissioner Dale LaGrone moved and Commissioner Billy Alexander seconded the motion to trade in five (5) copiers, one located in each of the following places: County Judge's Office, Panola County Road and Bridge Department, Panola County Detention Center, Panola County 911 Rural Addressing Office and Panola County Auto Registration Office; and approve Lease Agreement between Xerox and Panola County.
