

**PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS ORDINANCE 2021-02**

**A PANOLA COUNTY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND APPROVING DESIGNATED COUNTY ROADS MAINTAINED BY PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS TO BE “NO THRU TRUCKS” ROADS AND PROVIDING FOR PLACING SIGNS “NO THRU TRUCKS”; AND PROVIDING FOR A CLASS C MISDEMEANOR AND A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS AND PUBLICATION**

WHEREAS, a need exists to establish certain roads maintained by Panola County as “NO THRU TRUCKS” roads and for appropriate signs designating the road as a “NO THRU TRUCK” road and the following *Ordinance 2021-02* was adopted by the Court with all members voting “aye” to wit:

**DESIGNATED PANOLA COUNTY ROADS**

Be it ordained by this Court that the following roads which are maintained exclusively by Panola County, Texas (Panola County Roads) shall be established and designated as a “NO THRU TRUCKS” road and appropriate signs be placed on the following Panola County Roads.

**PANOLA COUNTY ROADS DESIGNATED AS “NO THRU TRUCK” ROADS:**

**2. Definition of a “TRUCK”**

The term “truck” is used to describe a “commercial motor vehicle” and a” truck tractor “defined by the Texas Transportation Code as currently exists or as hereby amended, but it does not include pickups, farm tractors, authorized emergency vehicle, ambulance, nor school busses.

**4. CRIMINAL OFFENSE AS A CLASS C MISDEMEANOR AND PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION**

It shall be unlawful and constitute a Criminal Offense of a Class C misdemeanor for any individual, Corporation, or Association to drive, operate, or move a commercial motor vehicle or a truck tractor on any Panola County Road designated as a “NO THRU TRUCKS” road with appropriate signs.

5. PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION

Any individual, corporation or association who shall willfully violate the provisions of this Ordinance or fail to comply therewith, shall be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor Criminal Offense and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) plus court costs, and each such violation shall constitute a separate and distinct offense thereunder.

6. PUBLICATION TO BE EFFECTIVE

This Ordinance shall be published twice in a Newspaper of General Circulation in Panola County; and thereafter this Ordinance and its Adoption and Publication shall be operative and effective as to the designated "NO THRU TRUCKS" Panola County maintained roads as for all purposes hereunder,

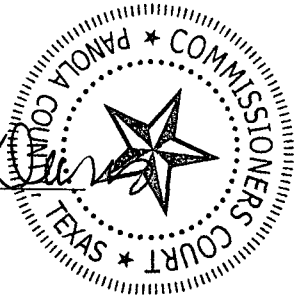
