

ORDER #2022-05

WHEREAS, V.T.C.A. Transportation Code, Section 40.27 allows a Commissioners' Court to establish a traffic control device system; and

WHEREAS, V.T.C.A. Transportation Code, Section 251.151 gives the Commissioners' Court of a county the right to regulate traffic on a county road; and

WHEREAS, Section 251.152 requires public hearing before the Commissioners' Court may issue a traffic regulation under that Subchapter (Subchapter E) and notice of the public hearing must be published not later than the seventh and not earlier than the 30th day before the date of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, Section 251.155 allows the Commissioners' Court to install a stop sign on the county road in order to be effective; and

WHEREAS, the Panola County Commissioners' Court called a public hearing for April 12, 2022 while meeting in Regular Session; and


WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was published in the Panola Watchman on Sunday, April 3, 2022, a date at least seven days but not more than 30 days before the public hearing; and


WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on Tuesday, April 12, 2022 at 1:30 p.m.;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, by the Commissioners' Court of Panola County, Texas, meeting in Regular Session at an officially called meeting, as follows:


1. A stop sign shall be installed at the intersection of Panola County Road #207 and Panola County Road #2091.
2. The Panola County Road and Bridge Department shall install appropriate sign as soon as possible; and
3. The stop sign shall be effective with the installation of the sign.


