

## ORDER #2022-21


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary from time to time for Panola County to purchase land and/or right-of-way; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code, Section 262.024(a)(6), the Commissioners' Court of Panola County, Texas may grant an exemption from the requirements of competitive bidding if such services are for the purchase of any land or right-of-way; and


**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners' Court of Panola County, Texas finds that the purchase of any land or right-of-way pursuant to Texas Local Government Code, Section 262.024 (a)(6) should be exempt from competitive bidding;


