

RESOLUTION GRANT/APPLICATION #5288401

WHEREAS, this resolution of Panola County, Texas, authorizes Rodger McLane, County Judge, to submit an application for the County Essential Services Program through the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office. This grant program provides financial assistance to counties for essential public services including law enforcement services, jail services, or reimbursement of extraordinary costs incurred for the investigation or prosecution of a capital murder or crimes committed because of bias or prejudice as defined in Article 104.004 of the Code of Criminal Procedure; and


WHEREAS, the County of Panola finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Panola County, that the Capital Murder Trial project be operated for the 2024/2025 fiscal years; and


WHEREAS, Panola County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Panola County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and


WHEREAS, Panola County designates Rodger McLane, County Judge, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, that Panola County approves submission of the grant application for the Capital Murder Trial to the Office of the Governor.


