

Beginning Jan. 1, 2025, the standard mileage rates for the use of a car, van, pickup, or panel truck will be: **70 cents per mile driven for business use**, up 3 cents from 2024. 21 cents per mile driven for medical purposes, the same as in 2024. 1 day ago
