


- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, April 21, 2025, whichever is earlier.


- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, October 23, 2025, whichever is earlier.
