

RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT FARM-TO-MARKET 10 IN PANOLA COUNTY FROM THE LOOP AND U.S. HWY 59 SOUTH TO THE INTERSECTION OF FARM-TO-MARKET 10 AND FARM-TO-MARKET 2260 BE DESIGNATED AS DEPUTY SHERIFF CHRIS DICKERSON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, **Chris Dickerson's** time as a Jailer, Dispatcher, Deputy Sheriff, Panola County Honor Guard, and member of the Texas Army National Guard will not soon be forgotten; and

WHEREAS, during his term as Deputy Sheriff **Chris Dickerson** was shot and killed while on duty on the 31st day of December, 2019; and


WHEREAS, **Chris Dickerson** was 28 years of age and leaves behind a wife, Krista Dickerson, and two young children, Kensley and Chelsey; and

WHEREAS, the County of Panola, Texas desires to honor **Chris Dickerson** for his heroic public service; and


WHEREAS, the County of Panola, Texas by authority granted in Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Rule 25-9 adopts this Resolution as an indication of its commitment, in support of HB 2638 to designate Farm-to-Market 10 in Panola County from the Loop and U.S. Hwy 59 South to the Intersection of Farm-to-Market 10 and Farm-to-Market 2260 as **Deputy Chris Dickerson Memorial Highway**; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners' Court of Panola County, Texas does hereby approve and request the Texas Department of Transportation designate Farm-to-Market 10 in Panola County from the Loop and U.S. Hwy 59 South to the Intersection of Farm-to-Market 10 and Farm to Market 2260 as **the Deputy Chris Dickerson Memorial Highway**.
