15. To discuss and act upon approving a 2026 Budget Amendment No. 3.

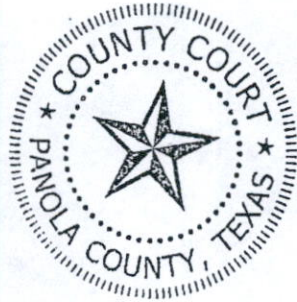
