SB224 Catalytic Converter Grant Program

RESOLUTION # R-PCSO-01-2026

A resolution of Panola County, Texas, authorizing Captain Adam Jones of the Panola County Sheriff's Office to submit an application for grant funds through the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority, which will provide funding for activities/projects with criminal justice purposes including law enforcement.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement agencies for economic automobile theft enforcement teams and to combat motor vehicle burglary in the jurisdiction; and


WHEREAS, this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat catalytic converter theft; and

WHEREAS, Panola County Commissioners' Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, Panola County Commissioners' Court assures that the grant funds will be returned in full to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ordered that County Judge Rodger McLane, is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Captain Adam Jones is designated as the Program Director and Panola County Auditor Jennifer Stacy, is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.


