

PANOLA COUNTY MORGUE SERVICES

This contract shall be entered into between **Hawthorn Funeral Home**, a Texas Corporation, and the **County of Panola**, Texas, a governmental body. The term of this contract shall be for a period of ten (10) years from July 18, 2026 to July 18, 2036.

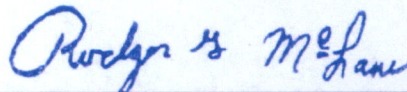
The County of Panola hereby authorizes the relocation of the County Morgue equipment from its present location at Jimerson-Lipsey Funeral Home premises owned by Hawthorn Funeral Home.

Hawthorn Funeral Home agrees to provide the installation of the County Morgue equipment mentioned above on their premises at its expense; and shall also provide operating room facilities and staff members to assist in removal of dead human bodies from place of death to the Panola County Morgue. Charges will be made in accordance with regular Funeral Home pricing for the removal of the body from place of death and transfer of the dead human bodies from the Panola County Morgue to a distant location for an autopsy to be performed. (General Price List Attached)

The County of Panola shall deem Hawthorn Funeral Home facilities to be the Panola County Morgue, therefore, with complete operating room facilities available and permanent full-time staff members of the facility available 24 hours per day.

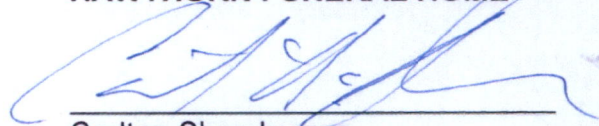

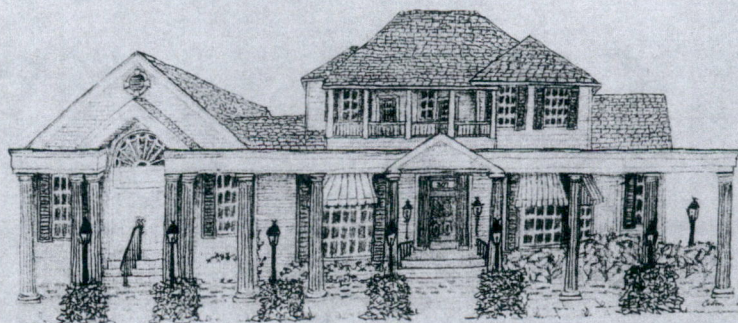

This is the basic charge to each family we serve for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also included in the charge is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, planning the funeral, and placement of obituary notices. There will be an additional charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING \$ 800.00

Embalming is a chemical process, which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by this state must complete this procedure. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Colors: Gold, Red, White, and Blue. These colors signify an American, Independent, family-owned enterprise rooted in tradition and service.

The Eagle: The eagle, olive branches, and arrows symbolize service to veterans from conflicts dating back to the Spanish-American War, honoring those who served in both times of war and peace.

The Shield: The shield is shaped to represent Panola County, Texas. The stars and stripes reflect loyalty and allegiance to the United States.
